Position Title: Bulky Waste Reporting Volunteer

Purpose: The Spence Neighbourhood Association is seeking dedicated and reliable volunteers to assist with reporting bulky waste in the neighbourhood. Volunteers will sign up to do regular bulky waste reporting.

Location: Will be working outdoors in the neighbourhood but reporting to 615 Ellice Avenue.

Time Commitment: Seeking year-round casual volunteers who would be required to report to the Community Connecting Coordinator once a month.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Spotting and reporting bulky waste to 311 accurately, including taking a photo if they can
- Filling out the Bulky Waste Report Form
- If volunteers run out of forms they are responsible to note down details, and retrieve new forms from the coordinator
- Return form and report monthly to the Community Connecting Coordinator

Skills & Qualifications:

- Ability to write
- Access to phone/email (can use 615 Ellice Street)

Benefits: Volunteers help to make the Spence Neighbourhood a safer place. They learn to identify and properly report safety concerns in their community. Volunteers are connected with training and learning opportunities. Volunteers will receive a \$5 Tim Horton's gift card per walkabout upon completion of the audit.
