

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

Position Title: Spring Seedling Steward

Purpose: The Spence Neighbourhood Association is seeking enthusiastic, passionate, and reliable volunteers to help plant and water vegetable seedlings for our community gardens.

Time Commitment: February to June, 1 day per week, approximately 2 hours per shift. Flexible hours, preferably weekdays between 9 am – 5pm.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Plant vegetable seedlings for community gardeners.
- · Water vegetable seedlings on a weekly basis.
- Keep clear records of varieties, timing and location of plantings.
- Transplant seedlings into larger containers as necessary.
- Tidy seed starting area as necessary.
- Move plants outdoors/indoors during hardening off period.
- Assist with the plant giveaway to community gardeners and the plant sale fundraiser.
- Other duties as assigned.

Skills & Qualifications:

- Knowledge of vegetable plants and experience gardening or starting seeds.
- Physically fit: able to climb stairs and carry 30 lbs.
- Ability to troubleshoot and solve problems with limited resources.
- Capable of working alone with minimal supervision.
- 18+ years
